Hazardous Materials

Course Description:

This course covers OSHA General Industry Standards for hazardous materials handling and integrates other national consensus standards that relate to hazardous materials, including flammable and combustible liquids, compressed gases, LP-gases, and cryogenic liquids. Related processes such as spraying and dipping are included, as well as electrical equipment. Upon course completion students will have the ability to assess compliance with OSHA hazardous materials standards, determine hazardous (classified) locations, and proper moving, storing, and handling of hazardous materials.

Topics include:

- Introduction to hazardous materials
- Hazardous locations
- Introduction to hazardous waste and hazardous response
- Hazardous waste site operations
- Emergency response and emergency action plans
- Compressed gases and acetylene
- Welding, cutting and brazing
- Liquefied petroleum gases
- Flammable liquids



OSHA 501 Trainer Course for General Industry

On successful completion, this course authorizes the student to become a trainer in the Outreach Program and to conduct both 10-hour and 30-hour general industry safety and health courses, and to issue cards to participants verifying course completion. Course participants learn effective instructional approaches and the successful use of visual aids and handouts.

- Present effective safety and health training programs in accordance with OSHA's general industry standards, regulations, and guidelines
